Cumberland County Public Safety Dementia & Autism Registry



In a first-of-its-kind pilot, Cumberland County is partnering with Simple Tracking System to allow citizens to register loved ones with conditions impacting their mental capacity and development as well as those to prone to wandering. This technology will make it easier for public safety to identify individuals in their times of need, provide necessary assistance, and reunite loved ones with their families. How does it work? REGISTER SOMEONE

Scan the QR code to provide your name and email address to request access to the registry. Once added, you will receive an email invitation to complete a registry record. The record includes information fields to assist public safety in helping someone in need, including a facial photo, as well as emergency contact information. Annually, you will be asked to verify information.



PUBLIC SAFETY ENGAGEMENT

If a public safety professional comes into contact with someone lost, wandering, or confused who seems to need assistance, they will enter any identifying information into the STS app, including a facial photo, and send to the registry.



IDENTIFY & ASSIST

The registry will automatically search for matches via image and data. If a match is found, public safety may access the registry record to assist the individual in need, including outreach to their emergency contact and reuniting them safely with family or a caregiver.
