Who We Are

SRS delivers an integrated locative and reunification platform designed to provide support to a community's most vulnerable population, accelerate missing-person recovery, and strengthen coordinated response for individuals with cognitive impairments, dementia, autism spectrum disorder, and developmental disabilities.

Our system enables agencies to rapidly locate and identify missing individuals through a secure purpose-built platform that supports caregivers, service providers, and public safety professionals. We do not rely on consumer devices or wearables; our platform is designed for operational use by public safety and human services agencies and integrates directly into organized response protocols.

Alignment with Funding Opportunities

Kevin and Avonte Program - Bureau of Justice Assistance (DOJ)

Grant Ceiling: \$150-\$500K per award

This program prioritizes:

- Locative technologies
- Wandering prevention
- Rapid rescue capabilities
- Law enforcement and care system collaboration

SRS directly supports these priorities by enabling agencies to deploy locative technology, establish structured response programs, facilitate family reunification and reduce injury and death among vulnerable populations.

Alzheimer's Disease Programs Initiative (ADPI) - Administration for Community Living (HHS)

Grant Ceiling: \$8M total for FY 25 / \$750K per agency award

This program prioritizes:

- Dementia-capable community systems
- Home and community-based services (HCBS)
- Technology-enabled safety
- Caregiver and provider support

SRS strengthens dementia-capable systems by embedding locative safety and response capabilities into community care models and support aging in place, while improving coordination between service providers and public safety agencies.

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Autism Community Impact Grant - Doug Flutie Jr. Foundation for Autism **Funding: \$10-\$15K per grant**

More about this grant:

- Must be a 501(c)3
- Prioritize underserved, underfunded, and culturally diverse communities
- Alignment with the key dimensions of informed, educated, supported, employed, active, social, and safe
- Geographic focus in New England and Central Florida

SRS supports an employed, active, social, but safe autism community by providing peace of mind to families in case of an emergency. As a cloud-based technology, our technology can be deployed anywhere.

Center for Dementia Respite Innovation Grants - Alzheimer's Association **Funding: \$100K-\$125K per award**

More about this grant:

- May fund the launch of a start-up program or enhance an already existing program with an innovative component
- Domestic public or private for-profit or non-profit entities are eligible, including state and local governments
- Eligible expense includes technology, training, and marketing and communications

SRS can be the primary component of your program or provide necessary innovation to an already existing one. Our technology already supports local governments in the U.S. but could partner with nonprofit entities in a local, regional or state rollout. In order to ensure the success of SRS, programs should ensure marketing and communications to their communities.

The Problem

Across the United States, thousands of individuals with cognitive impairments wander from safe environments each year. These events place individuals at high risk of injury or death and create significant strain on public safety and social service systems.

Current responses are often:

- Reactive after disappearance
- Manpower-intensive
- Dependent on broad search efforts
- Limited by incomplete situational awareness

Delays in locating individuals significantly increase harm, particularly for people with dementia or developmental disabilities.

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Our Solution: A Proactive Location & Response System

SRS provides a grant-eligible solution that includes:

- Locative technology allowing agencies to quickly identify and locate missing individuals
- Public safety integration delivering actionable location intelligence
- Caregiver and service provider interface for alerts and coordination
- Grant reporting and program metrics, including time-to-recovery and incident tracking

- Improved interagency coordination
- Increased community trust through successful outcomes
